| <b>P</b> | PRONUNCIATION | Pronunciation, intonation, rhythm, fluency and efficiency ( hesitation, broken speech) |
| <b>G</b> | GRAMMAR       | Speech organisation, grammatical correction and variety, connectors, speech cohesion.  |
| <b>V</b> | VOCABULARY    | Variety, correction, paraphrases strategies  |
| <b>C</b> | COMPLETION    | Length, register, task completion, speech coherence                                    |

In an exam every part or descriptor ( P, G, V and C ) carries a maximum of 5 marks, that makes a total of 20 marks for the whole tests. A total of **12 marks** out of 20 is normally needed to pass the exam.
