Aim

To practice the -ed sounds of past simple regular verbs.

Preparation

Make one copy of the worksheet for each student.

Level

Elementary

Time

25 minutes

Introduction

In this entertaining worksheet activity, students practice the -ed sounds of past simple regular verbs.

Procedure

Give each student a copy of the worksheet.

Ask the students to complete the conversation with the regular verbs from the box. Tell the students to write the verbs in the past simple tense.

When the students have finished, go through the answers with the class.
